Corrections.com Press Release Guidelines

Corporate members may submit press releases to be posted in the Business section of the *Corrections.com* home page. The release also will be posted in the *Corrections Connection*, the *Corrections.com* weekly ezine, and will be archived inside the member's CorrectSource profile.

If approved, press releases will be posted the day after they are submitted.

To maintain uniformity consistency and fairness, press releases should follow the format that is detailed below.

Members are encouraged to submit press releases about their company. If they feel they have more information to communicate, members should contact their media representative about advertising opportunities.

Below is an explanation on how to write a press release followed by an example of a press release.

How to write a press release

Press releases convey company information to the public. They announce new products or services, financial information, facility programs, personnel changes, company mergers, innovations, etc.

Press releases should include:

A title

Dateline

One or two paragraphs, of two or three sentences each, explaining the company news A quote from a company executive supporting the paragraphs

An ending paragraph with any additional information that supports the information in the release

An "About" paragraph – a paragraph about the company (where it's located, what it does, etc.)
